## Overview of what ASC provides



Al Siraat College is an Australian school in the Islamic tradition. We follow the Australian curriculum with an emphasis on our Islamic ethos.

### OUR PROGRAMS

- A daily Salat program that all students from Years 3-12 are expected to participate in congregation.
- Quran lessons from Foundation to Year 10 that teach children how to both read and memorise Quran.
- Islamic studies as a compulsory subject in all year levels with a focus on the Sunnah of the Prophet **عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ**.
- A robust sporting program for all students that may include interschool sporting activities.
- A LOTE program from Years 1-9 that currently is inclusive of the Arabic language only.
- Annual Camps for Years 3 to Year 9 that may include interstate travel for older year levels that all students are expected to attend.
- Several parent information workshops and seminars each term some of which are essential for parents to attend.
- Compulsory Primary outdoors morning assembly program.
- Are coeducational from Foundation to Year 4 and from Years 10-12. Same sex classes from Years 5 to 9 (separate girls' and boys' classes), aside from the accelerated (LEAP) and hands on learning (KLIC) programs.
