إِنَّا لِلْهُ وَإِنَّا إِلَيْهِ رَاجِعُونَ، اللَّهُمَّ أَجُرُنِي فِي مُصِينَةِ وَالْجِعُونَ، اللَّهُمَّ أَجُرُنِي فِي مُصِينَةِ وَأَخْلِفُ لَي خَيْرًا مِّنْهَا وَ أَخْلِفُ لَي خَيْرًا مِّنْهَا

She said: When Abu Salamah (R.A) died, I supplicated as Rasulullah (S.A.W) had ordered me; so Allah then granted me Rasulullah (S.A.W) as a husband, better than him.
